Applications are invited from researchers (in any discipline), with three years' postdoctoral research experience (or equivalent). Applicants should be based in Wales and working (i) at one of the St David's Day Group of universities (Aberystwyth, Bangor, Cardiff, Glamorgan or Swansea); or (ii) in business/industry/service sector research and development outside higher education.

Only 30 applicants will be selected to take part in the 2012 Welsh Crucible. All programme costs will be covered for the successful applicant.
